

## Definition

<b>Wi-Fi 6 Standards</b>	All IEEE 802.11ax standard specifications approved and adopted by IEEE.
<b>Consumer-Grade Wi-Fi 6 Product</b>	<p>A device that</p> <p>(1) supports Wi-Fi 6 Standards, but not subsequent Wi-Fi standards such as Wi-Fi 7 (802.11be), and</p> <p>(2) is a non-access-point (non-AP) station, or an access point designed primarily for small office, home office, residential, and/or personal use, such as residential router, personal hotspot, repeater, laptop, handset, smart speaker, TV, set-top box, or tablet.</p> <p>Consumer-Grade Wi-Fi 6 Product does not include access points with enterprise-grade performance or designed primarily for professional, business, or commercial use, such as in airports, hotels, factories, universities, convention centers, hospitals, parks, or commercial facilities.</p> <p>An instrument that incorporates two or more access points or non-access-point (non-AP) stations that individually meet this definition of Consumer-Grade Wi-Fi 6 Products should be considered as corresponding number of Consumer-Grade Wi-Fi 6 Products for the purposes of royalty calculation.</p>
